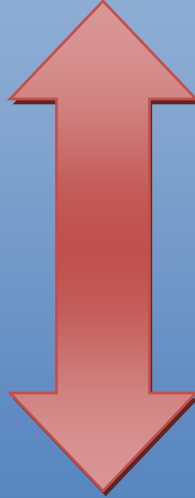
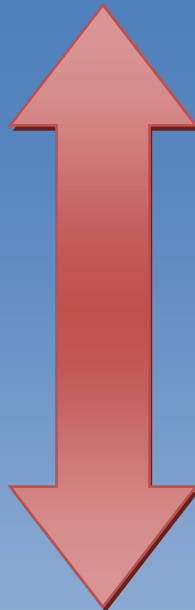

Shallow Tube Wells Installation for Drinking Water, Sanitation, Irrigation pumps In Sarlahi District Shallow Tube Well Installation for Drinking Water & Sanitation in Sarlahi District, 100 Shallow tube well in Sarlahi District, Sponsorship program to Orphan Children in Sarlahi District, Cash support to Orphan children for better education.

6.1 Shallow Tube well Installation for Drinking Water and Sanitation

Chetana Malangwa implemented the Project Shallow Tube Well Installation For Drinking water & Sanitation in Sarlahi district on 31th October 2019. The project was funded by Qatar charity Nepal. The main objective of the project was to



Provide Safe Drinking Water and proper Sanitation Facility To Needy and marginalized People at sarlahi district. The Project installed 100 Shallow Tube well of at Least 50 Meters depth government school In Coordination with QC Nepal. The Shallow Tube well were installed at 100 Different Location Of Sarlahi District. It Was Installed At 3 Municipalities Of Sarlahi district. The Project Provided shallow tube well to 50 families from marginalized groups of malangwa municipality Ward No.4 and 5, 1 Government Ward Office and 24 individual from marginalized groups from Haripurwa municipality. And 2 Government Schools, 1 Police Station,1 Health Office and 21 individual from marginalized groups from Ishwarpur municipality Ward No.15,Suknaha. As The Main Motive of Project Was to Cover Poor, needy ,Vulnerable and Marginalized Communities and government Schools in Sarlahi district so, The installed Shallow Tube Covers Marginalized groups individual and Government schools of Malangwa, Haripurwa and Ishwarpur municipality of sarlahi district . The arsenic test has been completed by Mr. Jitendra Ray concerned person from water and sanitation department of Malangwa sarlahi. The project has been timely monitored by Chetana Program Coordinator Mr,Mukesh Kumar Jayswal and chetana Board Representatives Need assessment and beneficiaries identification has been done of Government school and individuals. Coordination has been done with local government authority and stakeholders in the targeted community and after sharing the objectives after hydro geological survey. With the Grant support of Rs. 63,86,000.00 (Sixty Three lakhs Eighty thousand rupees only)from Qatar charity Nepal the Project Shallow Tube well Installation For Drinking water and Sanitation In Sarlahi District Completed to Safeguard Peoples Life From Unsafe Water, proper sanitation and to cover poor,Maginalized and Vulnerable Families and government schools ,Health Office, Ward Office of sarlahi district. .



6.2 Installation Of Irrigation Pumps In Sarlahi District

Chetana Malangwa implemented the Project Installation Of Irrigation Pumps in Sarlahi district on 31th October 2019. The project was funded by Qatar charity Nepal. The main objective of the project was to Provide Agriculture Purpose Irrigation Facility To Needy and marginalized People at sarlahi district. The Project installed 3 Shallow Irrigation Pumps of at Least 30 Meters depth Needy Farmers In Coordination with QC Nepal. The Irrigation were installed at 3 Different Location Of Sarlahi District. It Was



Installed At 1 Municipalities Of Sarlahi district. The Project Provided Irrigation Pumps to 18 families from marginalized groups of Haripurwa Municipality Ward No.3 and 4. As The Main Motive of Project Was to Cover Poor, needy ,vulnerable and Marginalized Communities Farmers in Sarlahi district so, The installed Irrigation Covers Marginalized

groups Community in Haripurwa Municipality of sarlahi district . The project has been timely monitored by Chetana Program Coordinator Mr,Mukesh Kumar Jayswal and chetana Board Representatives Need assessment and beneficiaries identification has been done of Needy Farmers individuals. Coordination has been done with local government authority and stakeholders in the

6.3 Strengthening the government capacities to respond to the Covid-19 for the migrants in Nepal

Chetana Malangwa implemented the Project Strengthening the government capacities to respond to the Covid-19 for the migrants in Nepal at Sarlahi on 15 June 2020 to 30 July. The project is awarded by START Network, UK (435 Nepal: Cross-border movement of migrants) to the consortium partners Qatar Charity (lead agency) and Islamic Relief Worldwide (Co-lead). Qatar Charity Nepal leads the project implementation with joint monitoring/facilitation by Islamic Relief Worldwide, Nepal. The project will cover the 20 quarantine center of 11 Municipality/Rural Municipality (Bishnu Rural Municipality, Kabilasi Municipality, Parsa Rural Municipality, Haripurba Municipality, Harivan Municipality, Kaudena Rural Municipality, Gaudeta Municipality, Basbariya Rural Municipality, Haripur Municipality, Bagmati

Municipality, Barhathawa Municipality) in Sarlahi District. The main objective of the project was to Ensure migrants workers are able to meet their basic lifesaving immediate needs and are safely treated at the 20 quarantine centers In Sarlahi District. The project Supported 20 temporary latrines with bathing cubicles constructed in quarantine centers • 20 contactless hand washing station installed in quarantine centers • 900 persons in quarantine centers received sets of hygiene kit • 65 women and adolescence girls received sets of dignity kit • 100 frontline medical workers received personal protective equipment (PPE) set

The Distribution Program was attained Chairman from DCC sarlahi Mr.Methur Chaudhary,Media Represtatives and other members of Chetana Malangwa, Municipality Mayor, Board Member and Ward Chairman, Project Officer Irshad Ali Shekh of Qatar Charity & Uma

With the project investment of NPR 3,769,150.00 (In words; Three Million Seven Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand and One Hundred Fifty Nepali Rupees only) Strengthening the government capacities to respond to the Covid-19 for the migrants in Nepal Project was completed well.
