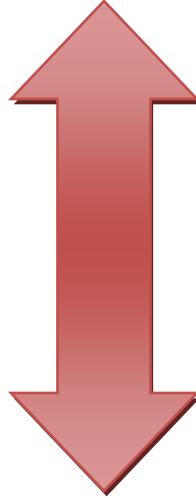
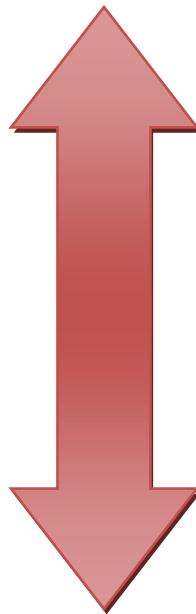

6.1 Small Scale Irrigation, Shallow Tube Well, Wheelchair and Try-cycle Support in Sarlahi District

Chetana Malangwa implemented the Project Small Scale Irrigation, Shallow Tube Well, Wheelchair and Try-cycle Support in Sarlahi district on 08th November 2024. The project was funded by Qatar charity Nepal. The main objective of the project was to Increase farm household incomes and food security reducing dependency on rain fed agriculture, Improve crop production and livestock health of smallholder farmers by irrigation support,



provide safe drinking water in household level focusing needy and poor families of rural villages & provide a more comfortable and safe way of travelling for people with disabilities, who may otherwise have difficulty with mobility to Needy and marginalized People at sarlahi district. The Project was provided 10 Irrigation Pumps installed to increase agriculture

production and food security, 1 Shallow tube well (60 m) installed in household level



ensuring safe drinking water facilities, 4 persons with disabilities (PWDs) received Try-



cycle for easy mobility & 1 person with disability (PWD) received wheelchair for easy mobility. In Coordination with QC Nepal As The Main Motive of

Project Was to Improving agricultural productivity to ensure food security and poverty alleviation, Provide safe drinking water and enhance sanitation facility to the poor family and community level & Enhance better health care facilities to needy persons in Sarlahi district.
